- Have demonstrated leadership ability
- Demonstrate service to their community

- **NARRATIVE 1: Attach no more than two typed pages (double spaced) providing a narrative which demonstrates the nominees innovative and creative leadership abilities indicating significant contributions as a result.**
 - **NARRATIVE 2: Attach no more than two pages (double spaced) providing a narrative which demonstrates involvement in FRPA.**
 - **NARRATIVE 3: Attach no more than one typed page (double spaced) providing a narrative which demonstrates community involvement. Please list, in order of importance to nominee, community, civic, professional, religious, social athletic and other organizations in which the nominee has been a member during the past three years.**
