Fundraising

- Progress continued towards the goal to secure a donor base of 500 parks and recreation professionals. One-hundred twenty two donors contributed a total of \$16,689 to the Foundation through a variety of ways including direct donations, United Way campaign giving and memorial gifts.
- The annual Auction at the Conference shattered the previous year's level raising \$17,304. Individuals, departments and businesses continued to generously donate items for the auction, led by the sponsorship of the Lee County Sports Authority.
- The Board continued to evaluate the investment strategies working closely with investment professionals.

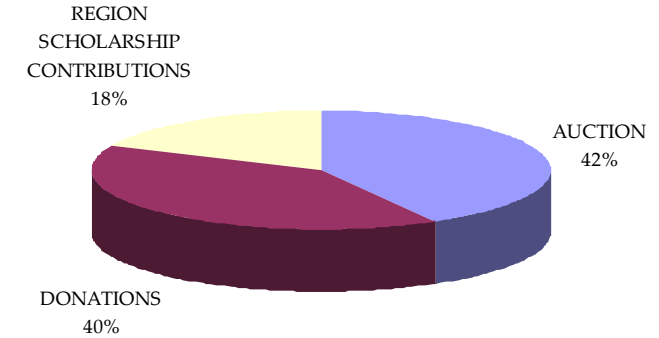

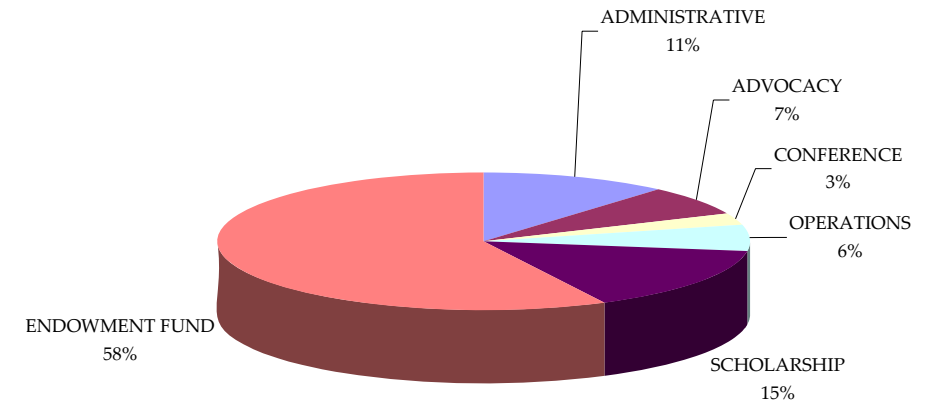
